One of the objectives of the Jamaican Canadian Cultural Association of BC (JCCABC) is to provide practical and tangible support to address the diverse social needs of our members and the community. In anticipation of these needs, JCCABC is pleased to support the educational pursuits of our members, volunteers and individuals in our community. Each year, the JCCABC awards scholarships to eligible individuals residing in British Columbia who are pursuing higher education at tertiary institutions. Applications are open from May to July of each year, afterwhich the committee reviews and makes final recommendations on the awardees. The Scholarship recipients are announced and the awards are issued during our Independence Celebrations in August.

Eligibility Criteria

To be considered for a JCCABC Scholarship, you must be:

- 1. A resident of British Columbia
- 2. A Canadian citizen or Permanent Resident
- 3. Enrolled full-time in a post-secondary institution in Canada

Selection Criteria

The decision to grant a scholarship is based on the following criteria:

- 1. Academic Achievement
- 2. Volunteer activities / community service
- 3. Personal Statement
- 4. Availability

Guidelines

- Scholarship applications are accepted annually. All persons who meet the
 eligibility requirements are encouraged to apply. Membership with the JCCABC
 is not mandatory. The deadline for submission is 11:59pm, June 30.
 Applications submitted after the deadline will not be assessed for the August
 disbursement at our Independence ceremony.
- 2. Please ensure you meet the eligibility requirements prior to applying.
- 3. Only completed applications with the required attachments will be considered.
- 4. All scholarship recipients are encouraged to attend the JCCABC Independence ceremony in August to accept the award.
- 5. Scholarship recipients agree to have their names and photographs highlighted in all JCCABC media, which may include print and electronic material.
